#### Travelling to Oslo:

By plane and train ⇒ If you come to Oslo by plane, the Airport Express train rides downtown Oslo every 10 minutes. It takes you to Oslo Central station and the hotels are all in walking distance.

#### Traveling to Lovisenberg University:

By train ⇒ You will arrive at Oslo Central station and the bus for Lovisenberg is leaving just outside from platform G and takes you to Lovisenberg in 18 minutes.

By bus ⇒ Bus number 37 from downtown Oslo takes 18 minutes and 4 minutes to walk.

On foot ⇒ Walking from downtown Oslo will take you 45 minutes.
