Conference Theme

The 16th European Conference of ACENDIO explores how Artificial Intelligence (AI), Standardized Nursing Languages (SNLs), digital health technologies, and interoperable data systems can strengthen nursing leadership, clinical reasoning, research, and education to improve patient outcomes. With experienced keynote speakers, we will address AI in person-centred care, research and education development, and healthcare education, particularly nursing informatics. The conference also highlights AI-driven applications, Big Data analytics, nursing-sensitive outcomes, and the effectiveness of nursing interventions, alongside person-centred digital care, patient participation, and standardized documentation within Electronic Health Records. Special emphasis is given to innovation, learning health systems, research methodologies, competency development, and education in the era of AI, including curriculum integration, evaluation models, and funding opportunities through the ACENDIO Grant.

Submission of abstracts

We invite you to submit abstracts for the conference according to the following guidelines:

Abstracts must be submitted electronically by 12.00 CET on October 20, 2026, via the ACENDIO abstracts link (<https://app.oxfordabstracts.com/stages/82298/submitter>)

1. All submissions will be acknowledged upon receipt.
2. Submissions may report **original research, project development/evaluation, practice applications or position papers**, and should always relate to the conference theme/subthemes; and must be named accordingly.
3. Abstracts must be submitted in English and the following information is required by the abstract management system:
 - Type of presentation must be indicated: **oral or poster**;
 - Title (max 20 words);
 - The first name(s) and last name(s) of author(s) and their main affiliation (Institution, City, and Country) should be included for each author. Professional titles, degrees, etc. should not be included. The presenting author needs to be indicated using the appropriate box;
 - Choose and indicate conference subtheme which best describes your abstract (see list at page 2).
4. The abstract should be structured as follows:
 - The **abstract**, which should not exceed 500 words.
 - The **abstract** should contain: **Introduction, study/project Aim/s, Methods, Results** (if any) **and Conclusions**. Tables and footnotes should be avoided.
 - **Keywords** that identify your study/project (minimum 2 keywords to a maximum 5 keywords).
5. Permission to publish should be indicated if the submission is accepted for presentation.
6. The scientific committee will consider all abstracts and recommend those for acceptance either as oral/poster presentation to the board of ACENDIO who will make the final decision on the nature of the presentation.
7. Authors will be notified by email, on or before December 20, 2026 of the outcome of their submission. No further correspondence will be entered into this regard.
8. Successful authors are required to register before January 15, 2027 (early bird fee).
9. Authors, whose abstracts have been selected for presentation, will be notified of the time, date, method and allocation of presentation in February 2027.

• Notification of acceptance	December 20, 2026
• Early registration open (early bird fee)	September 30, 2026
• Early registration ends/late registration open	January 15, 2027
• Late registration ends	March 10, 2027
